## OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE MCHENRY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

March 4, 2025

9:00 AM

Chairman Anderson called the meeting to order. Commissioners Brady Nelson, Duane Drader, Lance Johnson, Bryan Bruner and Armann Anderson present.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Bruner to approve the February 4<sup>th</sup> minutes. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Bruner and seconded by Drader to approve abatements 1619, 1625, 1626. Motion carried unanimously.

Tax Director/Zoning Admin Kristi Brodehl joined the meeting to present a variance application from Paul Thomas to re-establish a shelterbelt 45' from the center of 6<sup>th</sup> Ave N in the SW ½ NW ½ of Section 33-154-78. A motion was made by Bruner and seconded by Drader to approve the variance. Commissioners Bruner and Johnson voting aye. Commissioners Drader, Nelson and Anderson voting nay. Motion failed.

Correspondence was received from NDDOT, acknowledging receipt of the county's request to turn Co Rd 19 over to the State.

A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Johnson to re-advertise the Veteran Service Officer position. Motion carried unanimously.

A letter was received from Deputy Ryan Welsh requesting service credit for prior employment with McHenry County. A motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Bruner to follow the previous motion to not be retroactive in the decision to allow service credit. Motion carried unanimously.

No bids were received for the delinquent mobile homes.

The board held a phone conference with the Pierce County Commissioners and the Community Service Coordinator regarding the plan to fund the Community Service program since Bottineau County opted out. Pierce County assumed McHenry and Pierce would split the payment previously paid by Bottineau County. This will be looked into to determine if this is still a viable option for McHenry County.

Commissioner Johnson reviewed the list of vehicles and equipment to be sold at public auction. He will get a list together for advertising.

Kristi Brodehl informed the board Paul Thomas would be willing to place the shelterbelt 60' from the center of center of 6<sup>th</sup> Ave N in the SW ¼ NW ¼ of Section 33-154-78 and have 2 rows instead of 3. A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Bruner to approve the variance at 60'. Commissioners Bruner, Johnson and Anderson voting aye. Commissioners Nelson and Drader voting nay. Motion carried.

Commissioner Johnson left the meeting.

A consent motion was made by Nelson and seconded by Drader to approve the following: Treasurer's Miscellaneous Receipts #49782-49885; the monthly payroll in the amount of \$163,846.44 paid by warrant checks #28557 – 28605; Clerk of Court February County fees \$974.95, State fees \$13,506.05, Velva City \$20.00; County Recorder February recording fees of \$2,594.00 and misc fees of \$256.97; Sheriff February statement of fees \$834.53, Sheriff mileage \$980.00, Deputy reports for Feb.
